About the University and the Department of Political Science & Public Administration

Acharya Nagarjuna University located on the NH16 between the cities of Vijayawada and Guntur was established in 1976 by the Legislative Act of the then State legislature of the united state of Andhra Pradesh. It offers 47 courses both at the undergraduate and Post-graduate level. It is accredited by NAAC with "A" grade. More than 450 degree colleges located in the districts of Guntur and Prakasam are affiliated to the University.

Started with three faculty members in 1980, the Department of Political Science and Public Administration of Nagarjuna University gradually blossomed into a centre with strong commitment of teaching and research. Dr. C.V. Raghavulu, who was then a faculty member in the Department of Politics and Public Administration at Andhra University, Visakhapatnam joined Nagarjuna University as a Professor, and was entrusted with the task of building up the new department. The Department of Political Science & Public Administration offers post-graduate programmes both in the disciplines of Political Science and Public Administration since its inception.

About the workshop

The department of Political Science & Public Administration of Acharya Nagarjuna University is organizing a one day workshop on the theme "Reimagining Public Administration in the 21st Century" on 28th March, 2022. Public Administration as an academic discipline has to be reoriented in the context of redefining the role of the state from the late 90's onwards, when the economy was liberalized from the direct control of the state. There is a paradigm shift in the study of Public Administration towards New Public Management which brought the Principles of market economy into the theory of Public Administration. The New Public Management focuses its emphasis on deregulation, contracting out of public services, the use of competitive tendering and internal competition in service delivery, breaking up of formerly monopolistic organizations into semi-autonomous service centres, increasing emphasis on professional management in public sector etc. Thus the intention behind in conducting the workshop is to reorient the teaching faculty of Political Science & Public Administration working in various Degree Colleges in the state of Andhra Pradesh.

The objectives of the Workshop are

1. To familiarize as well as internalize the concepts of New Public Management to the faculty members.
2. To orient the faculty how to teach the New Public Management to the students.
3. To distinguish the traditional Public Administration from New Public Management.
4. To make them understand the social and intellectual context for the emergence of New Public Management
