The university is accredited with 'A' grade by NAAC, certified under ISO 9001 in 2016, achieved world university rank 801 + in BRICK. It also bagged several ranks like Green University, Gunnies world record etc...

### About the Department

The department of Education (M.Ed) was established in the Academic Year 2007-08 in University campus by fulfilling the long cherished dream and desire of the teacher education, research scholars and academician of ANU area. The second mile stone in the history of the department was the starting of M. Ed part time course in 2008 to the in-service teachers of the region. The vision of NEP 2020 has the potential to ensure that India turns out the students of a higher quality, equipped to take up professions and start a business almost as soon as they graduate.

NEP 2020 promotes a participatory, experiential learning approach to education and is a progressive

shift to a more scientific approach in education. The new educational structure caters to the child's cognitive development and provides them with social and physical awareness. It stresses the restructuring of school curriculum and pedagogy in a new design. It is primarily based on multidisciplinary of education through which every child will be allowed to do what he loves to do as an important step towards nation building. It offers a more flexible study route, letting students pick and choose their academic journey rather than conforming to the set standards and norms. With the multiple entry and exit options and a 4 year degree option, students would be able to move towards a more research based learning. For quality improvement of Teacher Education, it recommends that the stand-alone institutions into multidisciplinary colleges and Universities by establishing 4 year Integrated Teacher Education programme with exit option. The evaluation and assessment have also been transformed, which will eliminate examination phobia from the students. NEP 2020 focuses on the Integration of technology in both school education and higher education. It recommends that vocational education will be integrated to school and higher education in a phased manner. The NEP 2020 can make India one of the world's leading countries help children and youth achieve their potential, and eventually contribute to building an Atmanirbhar India.
